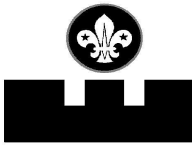
P.O.R. Rule 9.37 - Shooting (extracts)

No firearms may be acquired, held or used by any Scout unit or campsite unless the Group Scout Leader, District Explorer Scout Commissioner or Campsite Manager as appropriate has ascertained, understands and complies with any statutory requirements or bye laws relating to their possession and use.

Firearms may be taken on to Scout premises, camp sites, camps or on Scout projects or expeditions for use in accordance with [Policy, Organisation and] Rules provided that:

- prior permission in writing has been obtained, both from the home District/County Commissioner and from the person in charge of the premises, camp site, camp, project or expedition;
- adequate arrangements for the security of the firearms when not in use (including whilst in transit) have been made.

Note: County Commissioner's permission is relevant to The Scout Network and holders of County appointments only. Scouts, Explorer Scouts and holders of adult appointments within Groups or Districts need the permission of their District Commissioner.



Permission for Air Rifles / Air Pistols etc. to be taken on to Scout premises, camp sites, camps, Scout projects or expeditions.

P.O.R. Rule 9.37 - Shooting (extract)

No firearms may be acquired, held or used by any Scout unit or campsite unless the Group Scout Leader, District Explorer Scout Commissioner or Campsite Manager as appropriate has ascertained, understands and complies with any statutory requirements or bye laws relating to their possession and use.

Firearms may be taken on to Scout premises, camp sites, camps or on Scout projects or expeditions for use in accordance with [Policy, Organisation and] Rules provided that:

- prior permission in writing has been obtained, both from the home District/County Commissioner and from the person in charge of the premises, camp site, camp, project or expedition;
- adequate arrangements for the security of the firearms when not in use (including whilst in transit) have been made.

Note: The written permission of the landowner or occupier is required for firearms to be taken onto Scout or non-Scout premises in the course of a Scout activity.
